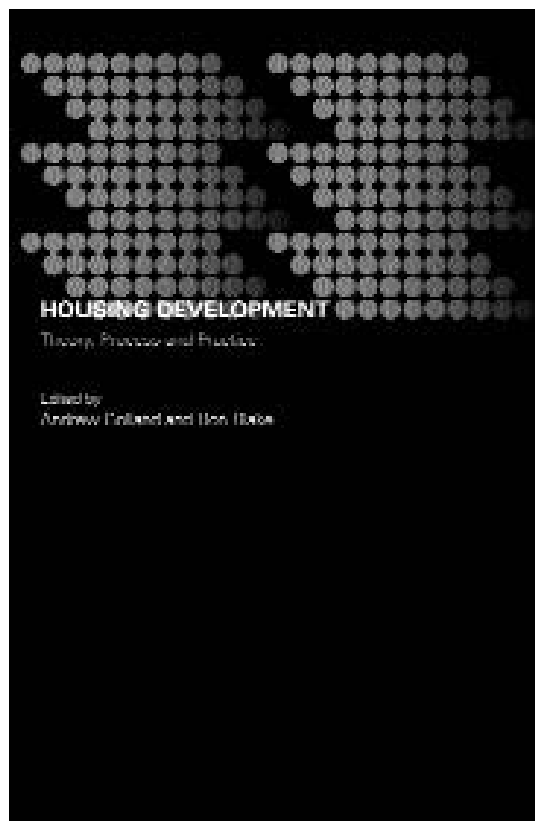


# Housing Development
